

The Human Impacts of no Israel-Palestine Peace Agreement

Peace is a state where people live without fearing the loss of their lives, homes, property or human rights and freedoms though hostile actions by an outside community or nation.

Obstacles to peace are hostile actions against a community or nation that kill people, destroy homes or property, expropriate land, cause human harm or restrict basic human rights and freedoms.

In 1967 the Israeli military occupied the Palestinian West Bank, East Jerusalem, and Gaza. The U.N passed resolution 242 stating Israel must withdraw all occupying forces.

In 1993, in the Oslo Peace Accords, Israel and the Palestinian Authority recognized each other. **Both parties agreed that a permanent peace agreement would be signed by May, 1996.**

Today there is still no peace agreement. Many Israelis and Palestinians say they want a peace agreement, but claim “the other side” is throwing up obstacles to peace by taking hostile actions against them.
